

## ACADEMIC AWARDS

- **Honor Roll:** Granted to students, Grades 5-12, who have maintained a GPA of 3.5 to 3.75, have demonstrated good citizenship, have maintained a minimum 'B' in Citizenship grade, and have not received "U" grades in Cooperation in any course.
- **Life Honor Roll:** Granted to senior students who have been on Honor Roll list 5 out of the last 6 semesters.
- **Principal's Award:** Granted to students Grades 5-12 who have maintained a GPA of 3.75 or above, who have demonstrated good citizenship, minimum 'B' in Citizenship grade, and have not received "U" grades in Cooperation in any course.
- **Life Principal's Award:** Granted to senior students who have been on the Principal's list 5 out of the last 6 semesters.
- **Perfect Attendance Award:** Granted to students Grades 1-8 who have maintained perfect attendance record throughout the year.
- **Citizenship Award:** Granted to students Grades 1-8, who have maintained excellent behavior record in all classes throughout the year.
- **President's Award for Educational Excellence:** Granted to students 5-12 who have maintained a G.P.A. of 3.5 or above and have obtained 85% on a standardized test in total Reading or Math.
- **California Scholastic Federation Awards:** Is a statewide honor society that recognizes high school students with high academic achievement as stipulated by the CSF eligibility formula, and who have worked as active CSF members.
  - CSF Highest Honor is presented to students who have been CSF members for six semesters
  - CSF Seal-bearers are the students who have maintained membership in CSF for four or more semesters including once in the senior year.
- **Valedictorian:** The valedictorian award will be given to all graduates who earn a weighted GPA of 4.00 or better in the first seven semesters of the High School and who have maintained a minimum 'B' in Citizenship grade. If none of the students satisfy these requirements then the student with the highest GPA will receive this honor. A valedictorian, who excels in Citizenship, character, behavior, and service-related qualities, will be selected to address the commencement exercises.
